1. Under national O.S.H.A. regulations, we reserve the right to refuse connection to wiring or equipment we deem hazardous.
2. All equipment and cords must meet National Electrical Code requirements and are subject to inspection by on-site engineer.
3. All equipment must have proper conforming caps or plugs and wiring.
4. To avoid delay of electrical installation, all equipment should be properly tagged with complete identification of current, voltage, phase, cycle, horsepower, etc.
5. Wall and post outlets are not a part of booth space. A separate outlet must be ordered for each booth using electrical service.
6. Each motor one (1) horsepower or greater must be equipped with a fusible switch.
7. All equipment and materials furnished by the hotel remain the property of Beaver Run Resort. A \$25.00 fee will be charged on any electrical cords which are lost.
